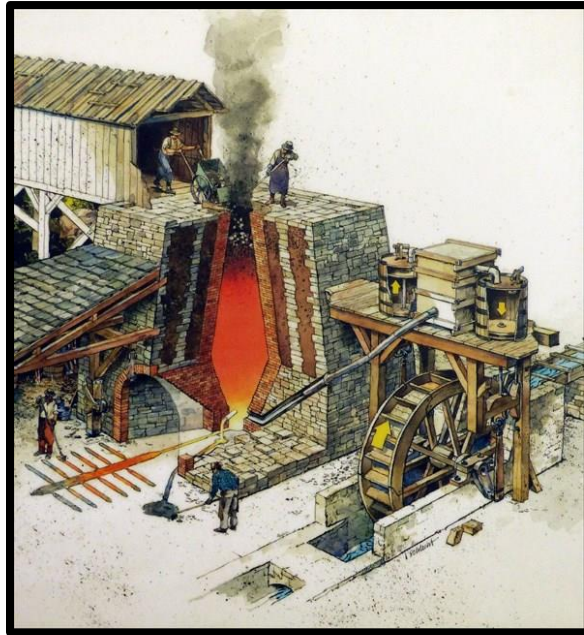


THE ARCHAEOLOGY OF THE NORTHAMPTON FURNACE
